Once wells are dug and built, schools are also built, and kids can go to school instead of spending all their days walking for water. We are proud of the total money raised for this offering during the noisy offering earlier this year (\$105.00), plus the offering during Vacation Bible School (\$329.43) for a generous total of \$434.43. What a difference a little knowledge, generosity, and love can make in 2021!!

Trustees' Report

The Trustees met with the Ford Construction representative to visit about the beginning of the remodeling of the bathrooms for the church. Plans were made to begin work early in July. The representative also felt it would take about 4 weeks rather than the extended period of time suggested in the first contract.

Decisions were made to purchase new toilets and sinks. This keeps everything under warranty with the installers rather than piecemealing the equipment being installed.

Plans were made for storing some tools in the basement during the construction. There will be times

Sveto Djokic has pruned the Spirea bushes at the church. This is such an attractive face for this old building. Thank you, Sveto, for your generous donation of time and skills. He also repainted the structure over the ramp into the dining room in an effort to keep it in good shape.

There are still so many jobs to be done around the building. The other entrance porches need a new coat of stain, the cross in the park needs a new coat of paint. There are repairs needed to some of the windows in the overflow room.

The care of this big building is never ending. The Stewardship Letter went out at the end of June. The funds raised from the congregants and community are much appreciated and will be used to help keep the large church and community building in good repair. Thank you to all who choose to help us with the structural upkeep.
